LE CHÂBLE/LES RUINETTES

- 1. The transport from Le Châble to Les Ruinettes is at 2:00 pm.
- Access to Le Châble station for large items is via the goods lift.The key for the goods lift can be obtained at the ticket office.
- No large items may be transported outside of the specified times, with the exception of ski equipment and small items of luggage, which guests may transport directly.
- 4. Guests must ensure sufficient hands are available for loading and unloading large items at the stations.
- If the gondolas are not coupled, there should also be people on site in Verbier to ensure the transfer of the large items to Les Ruinettes.

LES RUINETTES/LE CHÂBLE

- 1. The transport from Les Ruinettes to Le Châble is at 11:00 am via Médran 2 or Médran 4.
- 2. When the Le Châble-Verbier gondolas and Médran 2 are not coupled, large items are transported via Médran 4.
 - Large items should be transported directly from the holiday home to the installation (no storage at the station).
- 3. Guests must ensure sufficient hands are available for loading and unloading large items at the stations.
 - If the gondolas are not coupled, there should also be people on site in Verbier to ensure the transfer of the large items to Le Châble.

1. DINING ROOM

- · The tables and chairs must be stacked.
- The floor must be vacuumed and mopped using the equipment provided.
- · All windows must be closed.

2. KITCHEN

- The fridge and freezer must be emptied and cleaned.
- \cdot The dishwasher including the filter must be emptied and clean.
- · The oven and microwave must be cleaned.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ The utensils must be stored correctly on the shelves and in the drawers.
- The floor must be vacuumed and mopped.
- · All windows must be closed.

3. TOILETS

- \cdot The toilet bowls must be cleaned inside and out.
- · The rubbish bins must be emptied.







1. RUBBISH BINS

- · All rubbish bins provided must be emptied.
- Take the rubbish bags to the special area next to the gondola platform.

2. ROOMS

- Strip the sheets and pillowcases and place them in the laundry bin by the lift.
- · Leave the mattress protectors on the beds.
- The blankets must be folded and returned to the cupboards in the corridor corresponding to each room number.
- · Clean the shower and bathroom (washbasin, mirror).
- The floor must be vacuumed and mopped.
- · All windows must be closed.



By staying at La Maison des Ruinettes, you are entering into a rental agreement. A component of this agreement is the La Maison des Ruinettes house rules, compliance with which is mandatory. Failure to comply with these rules may incur penalties such as additional costs on your final bill.

1. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

- · You may arrive in the afternoon from 2:00 pm.
- · You must depart by 11:00 am.
- Upon arrival, you will be handed keys, a welcome booklet with house rules, waivers and an inventory.
- · An inspection will be carried out at the start and at the end of your stay.

2. MATERIAL PROVIDED

- This accommodation is rented out with beds and mattresses, bedding and pillows. During your stay, you must leave the sheets on to cover the mattress. You must also leave the pillowcases on.
- Mattresses are fitted with a mattress protector which must be clean and fitted on the beds when you leave.
- Beds shall be made up for your arrival and must be stripped in accordance with the household checklist description.
- Other linens (decorative throws, towels, tea towels and sleeping bags) are not provided.
- Heating at La Maison des Ruinettes is controlled remotely via Siemens boxes. Please do not touch these boxes yourself and inform us of any problems.

3. USING THE PROPERTY

- The accommodation is furnished. Please ensure you treat the furniture properlyand keep it clean.
- Water, electricity and heating are included in the rent. However, with
 environmental protection in mind, please switch off the lights when
 leaving a room, don't leave water running and don't keep the windows and
 doors open for a long time if you are using the heating.
- Every convenience is at your disposal subject to normal and reasonable use. With this in mind, please do not flush anything apart from toilet paper in the toilet.
- The access door to the home is fitted with a badge-operated lock. Please ensure you lock the door when you leave the house. You are responsible for any theft or damage if you fail to comply with this clause.

4. SAFETY AND ETIQUETTE

- · Smoking inside is strictly prohibited.
- In the event of an emergency, please call the emergency services (118 for fire brigade, 114 for medical emergencies and 117 for the police). Fire extinguishers have been provided in the home.
- In the event of a fire, please refer to the procedure available next to the fire box.
- Should the fire alarm be set off as a result of your negligence, you will be charged the cost for any action taken and any fines issued by the communal services.
- Wearing ski boots in shared areas or bedrooms is strictly prohibited.
 Please use the mud room at the entrance to La Maison des Ruinettes,
 where you can leave your ski equipment.
- The rotating spit in the shared area does not work and cannot be used.
- You must close the windows if there is a risk of rainfall or snowfall.
 Windows must be closed when you leave the property. You will be charged for any damage caused by rain or snow inside the property.

P. 26 MAISON DES RUINETTES P. 27

- Access to the gondola station is strictly prohibited outside the opening hours. A secondary exit has been provided should you wish to leave outside the opening hours of the Les Ruinettes station.
- For your safety, accessing the ski slopes is strictly prohibited outside opening hours.
- Sledging is prohibited on the ski slopes, even after the area closes or before it opens.

5. CLEANING CHARGE

- A cleaning charge may apply at the end of your stay if you have decided not to clean or if an inspection after you leave reveals that cleaning was insufficient.
- \cdot In this case, a cleaning charge of CHF 35 per hour will be applied.
- Please do not leave the accommodation in disarray by ensuring you tidy up the furniture, objects and tableware and empty the bins.

6. SEPARATING RUBBISH

- · Bins have been provided.
- Please comply with rubbish separation rules (plastic, paper, glass and aluminium) using the handy posters provided.

7. PROBLEMS

- If something breaks down or stops working in the accommodation, please contact us immediately. We shall do our best to remedy the situation.
 No reimbursement for call-outs or repairs will be accepted without our agreement.
- In the event of breakage, an accident or deterioration, please report it
 during your stay, even if no damage is apparent. In the event of loss or
 deterioration to items in the accommodation, fees may be charged for the
 cost of fixing or replacing the item.


