

SAFETY RULES

BASIC RULES

- Strictly follow the signposted instructions and warnings. Stay in the authorised signposted areas of the 4 Vallées facilities and premises.
- Follow the marked pathways, only load and unload in the areas signposted for this purpose.
- Do not bounce or swing on the chairlift.
- Do not hold objects off the lifts, or throw or drop anything.
- Once you have arrived at the unloading area, unload and leave immediately in the direction indicated on the sign.
- Do not smoke in the stations or on the lifts.
- Do not try to start the lift facilities.
- Do not abusively activate emergency stop devices.
- Refrain from damaging or soiling equipment and facilities.
- Do not interfere with the proper functioning of the equipment and facilities.

SPECIAL RULES

- Children under 1.25 metres tall (4ft1in) are not allowed to travel unaccompanied on chairlifts. Persons accompanying children must be capable of duly assisting them. Special rules may apply for children in groups.
- Skiers and pedestrians may not travel on the same chairlift seat (except for persons with disabilities who can be accompanied in accordance with the applicable rules).
- Passengers may not access the loading area unless operating staff is present. Persons requiring assistance in loading or unloading shall inform staff accordingly.
- Before loading, passengers must remove the straps of their skipoles and hold their poles firmly in one hand.
- Passengers must respect the speed, timing and capacity of the lifts.
- Passengers who get on incorrectly should not try to hang on, but should let go immediately.
- Safety bars must be lowered and raised as instructed; each passenger must take into account the other passengers sharing the chair.
- Jumping off chairlifts is prohibited even in case of prolonged stoppage.
- For lifts taken with skis on, skis must be maintained parallel, with their tips up, in the direction of travel, and resting on the foot rest, if there is one.
- Before unloading, passengers should ensure they are not caught on the seat.
- On arrival, if unloading is delayed, passengers must remain seated and await instructions from the operating staff.

Users who do not respect these safety rules may have their passes withdrawn without notice. Depending on the circumstances, 4 Vallées reserves the right to take legal action.
