Verbier's ski area opens this Friday!

Friday, November 10:

- Le Châble Verbier gondola (the line is currently undergoing maintenance work and will enter continuous service again from Saturday, 11 November). For this reason, there are several options for getting to Verbier on November 10: drive to Verbier and park in the different Verbier parking lots. The other option is to park at the Curala parking lot in Le Châble, then take a bus to the ski resort. See timetables <u>here</u>.
- Médran 2 gondola from 8.45am to 4.15pm
- Lac des Vaux 1 ski lift from 9am to 4.15pm
- Funispace from 8.50am to 4pm

Saturdays and Sundays in November:

- Le Châble Verbier gondola from 5.15am. to 11.50pm.
- Médran 4 gondola (Barnes Line) 8.45am 4pm
- Funispace from 8.50am to 4.15pm
- Lac des Vaux ski lift 1 from 9am to 4pm
- Attelas chairlift from 9am to 4.15pm

The resort will open on weekends only in November and is scheduled to open daily from 2 December.

The Médran (Verbier) and Le Châble sales points are open from Monday to Sunday. You can find comprehensive information on which lifts are open and when they are operating <u>here</u>.
